Amnesty Scheme

As announced in **Budget 2024 – 2025**, the Development Bank of Mauritius Ltd (DBM) will extend the Amnesty Scheme for the write-off of long outstanding loans of more than 20 years. Beneficiaries should however settle all legal fees if any. The scheme will be effective up to **30 June 2025**.

Planters, Breeders, Fishermen and Micro Entrepreneurs having long outstanding loans of more than 20 years shall be eligible under the Amnesty Scheme. Deceased Planters, Breeders, Fishermen and defunct Micro Entrepreneurs will also be eligible.

Planters, Breeders, Fishermen, Micro Entrepreneurs and representatives of deceased borrowers eligible under the Scheme are requested to submit their application forms duly completed to the DBM Head Office or any Branch. Forms can be downloaded from the Website of DBM www.dbm.mu or can be collected at the Head Office or any Branch of DBM Ltd.
